Accessibility

Diemen is located to the east of Amsterdam, in the middle of the urban area. This location offers many benefits for accessibility of Amsterdam as well as of other parts of the country.

By car the municipality can be reached easily via the national highways A1 (Amsterdam-Amersfoort), A2 (Amsterdam-Utrecht), A9 (Gaasperdammerweg) and A10 (ring road around Amsterdam).

There are two NS-train stations. The Diemen train station is located on the railway line AmsterdamAmersfoort/Almere. With this railway line you will be at Amsterdam central station in 10 minutes.

The Diemen-South train station has a direct link to Schiphol/The Hague and Lelystad/Hilversum. From this station you travel to Schiphol Airport in 20 minutes.

Diemen has been rated the best accessibility municipality by public transport. Besides the trains there is also the Amsterdam subway (line 53) in Diemen, as well as several bus routes and of course tram line 19. With the tram you can be in the centre of Amsterdam in about 25 minutes. This tram line comes past, amongst others, the Dapper market, the Tropical Museum and Leidseplein.
